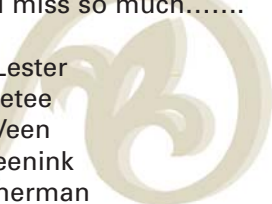

## Generations at Camp Henry

It is rare for an American family to have so much of their history tied to one small place but for five generations of Moores, Camp Henry is that place. When Lee Moore's granddaughter Jessica arrives at Hunter-Jumper Camp this summer, she will be carrying on a family tradition that started even before Camp Henry opened its doors in 1937.

Ira and Florence Moore moved to Grand Rapids in 1933 and joined Westminster Presbyterian Church. Soon after, the church decided to form a steering committee to explore the possibility of opening a children's summer camp and Florence volunteered. She loved camping and often took her children on camping trips.

Lee was 17 when the family moved to Grand Rapids, but his younger brother Alan became the very first camp 'gofer'. His sister Jeanne was one of the first campers and later a counselor.

After World War II, Lee and his wife Marjory moved back to Grand Rapids and soon his children were ready for camp. Scott, Jody, Bruce and Marilynne all went to Camp Henry as did many of their first cousins. Lee became more involved with camp in the early 1970's when he became a board member and eventually president of the Camp Henry board.

Lee's grandchildren have also attended Camp Henry as well as five great-grandchildren! We hope to have at least four Moores at camp this summer.

When Lee Moore turns 90 this April, he will have a long and productive life to contemplate. He thinks that the reason he is still here on earth is because he can still help people. He does that beautifully through his continued interest in Camp Henry as well as his involvement in other non-profit organizations and projects.

### Camp Henry Bridges into the Community

After a successful pilot program last year, Camp Henry launched BRIDGES, an in-school team and leadership program early this spring! The BRIDGES program emphasizes individual transformation by engaging students in exercises focused on positive communication, leadership, problem solving and making positive choices.

After an initial Needs Assessment, our team uses portable teambuilding elements and initiatives in the classroom for selected periods of time. We also train key staff at the school in practical and easy teambuilding techniques to use after the program is over. After four to six in-school sessions, we encourage a trip to Camp Henry to put everything into practice on our low and high ropes course to reward the kids for a job well done!

So far we have had great success with the Godwin Middle School Safe and Drug Free program and we have

been chosen to assist with the Grand Rapids Parks and Recreation Summer Program. If you are a teacher, principle, coach or leader of a youth group that could use team and leadership development, BRIDGES may be the way to go!

## Camp Henry to celebrate 70 years in 2007!



**Did you know?** Camp Henry was born almost 70 years ago in the spring of 1936. Westminster's pastor, Dr. Edward Downey, believed that it was vital to focus on the youth of our church. He enlisted the support of Henry Idema, who pledged \$5,000 toward building a church camp for Westminster.

By May, 1936, our present location on Kimball Lake had been selected and purchased for a total of \$1,900. The original camp buildings were built by Owen-Ames-Kimball with trees cut from the camp property.

By June, the main lodge and four cabins had been erected. Camp was officially dedicated at a congregational meeting in the new lodge on June 15. At that meeting, the congregation also voted to hire its first full-time director of music a decision that allowed the church to start both the Carol and Kirk Singer programs for youth.

Although Camp was not "officially" in operation during the summer of 1936, a modified camping experience was offered under the direction of Henry Schrupp, a parishioner and high school teacher. His camp program included swimming, canoeing, biology instruction and evening campfires. In the meantime, construction continued with volunteers from church building bunks, clearing the grounds, and doing other manual tasks.

As a final activity, a retreat was held in late summer for young people from all the Presbyterian churches in the area. Teens from Grand Rapids, Grand Haven, Spring Lake and other communities joined Westminster youth at camp for a very special time.

The spring and summer of 1936 marked the beginning of 70 years of fun, friendship and growth for countless numbers of youth from Westminster as well as from our West Michigan community and beyond. We hope that you will also help us celebrate our 70th anniversary next year!

### did you know?

- Camp Henry served 24,444 meals to 2005 summer campers.
- Camp Henry served 15,391 meals to 2005 retreat and year-round groups.
- Camp Henry served 4,635 persons in 2005 in retreat and year-round groups.
- Camp Henry Westminster-By-The-Lake Sunday church service attendance runs from 100-350 per Sunday from Memorial Day to Labor Day. All offerings support the scholarship fund, and over \$13,000 was raised in 2005!
